Rooms and Meals- The state budget increased municipal revenue sharing through the Rooms and Meals Tax by more than 45%, including nearly \$1.4 million for towns in District 11. (HB2)

Municipal Road Construction- The Legislature provided an additional \$30 million for local road construction, including nearly \$1.2 million for towns in District 11. (SB 401)

Municipal Bridge Projects- The Legislature added an additional \$36 million for municipal bridge projects including more than \$1.3 million for towns in District 11. (SB 401)

Extraordinary Needs Grants- The Legislature is sending an additional \$24 million to school districts with the greatest financial needs in Fiscal Years 2023-24, including more than \$100,000 for schools in District 11. (HB 420)

Statewide Property Tax- The Legislature cut the Statewide Education Property Tax (SWEPT) by \$100 million in Fiscal Year 2023, saving taxpayers in District 11 more than \$4 million. (HB 2)

The Legislature has delivered **more than \$8 million** to help lower property taxes in towns of District 11 just in grants that have already been allocated.
